## *From the Desk of Fr. Francis*

Congratulations to our newly baptized and confirmed. This is the largest group at least since my time at St. Therese. It was inspiring to witness Deacon Christian baptize his own mother. God is working wonders in our midst. We welcome our new Catholics and we pray for them as they continue to grow in their love for God and the Church.

### **Divine Mercy**



As we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday, first of all I would like to remind you that every first Friday of the month, our Church offers a Holy Hour, at which we pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet. You are always welcome to join us for this special devotion. Secondly I would like to share with you a great resource for your own prayer and reflection---*The Diary of St. Faustina*, which contains 356 short daily reflections. Below is an example for April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2018:

Is it better to do great works, or small sacrifices? It's easy to conclude that some great work for God is far better than any small sacrifice. But is it? That all depends upon the Will of God. Sometimes we take on some "great work" for God but, in the end, it's not part of His plan. A work is great only when it is done because God inspired it and remains the one leading it. Conversely, if God inspires a very small sacrifice on your part and you accept it and live it, then you can be assured that this small sacrifice will do more good for the salvation of souls than any other sacrifice you could ever dream up on your own. In fact, trying to force the Will of God to conform to your own will, inevitably, does more damage for the Kingdom of God than good, even if *your* idea seems holy (See *Diary* #639).

Either we do great works or small sacrifices, doing the will of God makes it worth.



## Two New Ministries

In the last few months, I have been discussing with our Liturgy Committee and Parish Pastoral Council members on the need to keep our Church clean and safe. There is a saying, “cleanliness is next to godliness.” Currently, our Church is cleaned monthly. We would like to add a second monthly cleaning. This will take place on the first Saturday of the month. It will be titled, “*Saturday Service Ministry*,” which will be led by volunteers.

The second initiative is named “*Caring Church Ministry*.” With all the robberies and violence that have been going on in our neighborhood and city, we would like to create a safe environment for our parishioners and visitors to worship in our beautiful Church. Currently, I have five people signed up. I am hoping to get five to ten more. Thanks to those who already said yes. Training will be provided for this ministry.

### "CALLED TO BELIEVE" ~Sister Caritas

These past few weeks, many people here in Chicago have been very excited about the wins of Loyola's basketball team. With each win the excitement and the involvement of people grew. People from all over the country began to know about Sister Jeanne and Loyola University.

In the Gospel today, Jesus comes to the Apostles on Easter evening. They are still hiding in the Last Supper room, with the door locked. Jesus comes into their midst with the greeting, "Peace be with you." He gives them the Holy Spirit and the power to forgive sin. They are filled with joy because they as a group know Jesus is alive. Thomas is not there and when told, he will not believe. He says, "Unless I see the marks of the nails and put my fingers into the place of the nails, I will not believe." The following week (Thomas has lived a whole week of unbelief), all the Apostles are together and Jesus comes again. He calls Thomas out and tells him to put his finger into the place of the nails and no longer doubt but believe. Thomas responds with faith.

So which one of the people are you? Are you willing to believe the testimony of the community? Does the witness of your friends and the Church enliven faith in you and your faith grows big enough to share with others? Are you like Thomas? Unless I see and touch...for myself, I will not believe.

We as a Church and as individuals, are called to witness to the Risen Jesus. He is alive. He is not dead. He has overcome sin and death. Once He died, He will not die again. He is alive with us now, today. We are to live this out in our lives. We are to be so strong in our faith that others will be drawn, be welcomed, and come to faith. This is the Apostolate, the Mission, of St. Therese Church.
